

## Works Cited Page Guide – Frequent Sources

### Book written by one person

Author's Last Name, Author's First Name. *Title of Book*. Place of Publication: Publisher,  
Year of Publication. Type of Source.

#### **Example:**

Henley, Patricia. *The Hummingbird House*. Denver: MacMurray, 1999. Print.

### Reference Book (Encyclopedia, Biographical Dictionary, etc.)

Author/Editor's last name, Author/Editor's first name. "Title of Entry." *Title of  
Encyclopedia/Book*. Edition (if known). Year of Publication. Type of Source.

#### **Example:**

Sturgeon, Theodore. "Science Fiction." *The Encyclopedia Americana*.  
International Edition. 1995. Print.

### Website

Author's last name, Author's first name. "Title of Webpage." *Title of Main Website*. Date page  
was created or updated. Name of page's sponsor. Date accessed.

#### **Example:**

Lynch, Tim. "DSN Trials and Tribble-ations Review." *Psi Phi: Bradley's  
Science Fiction Club*. 1996. Bradley University. 8 Oct 1997.

## Image from the Internet

Artist last name, Artist first name. "Title of Image." Digital image.

*Title of larger site.* Date of download. <[http://electronic\\_address\\_of\\_image.jpg](http://electronic_address_of_image.jpg)>

### **Example:**

Picasso, Pablo. "Guernica". 1937. Digital image. *Art in the Picture.* 12 April

2007. <[http://www.artinthepicture.com/artists/Pablo\\_Picasso/guernica.jpeg](http://www.artinthepicture.com/artists/Pablo_Picasso/guernica.jpeg)>

## Television or Radio Program

"Episode Name." *Series or Program Name.* Writer. Director. Producer. Network. Station

Viewed, City, Original Air Date.

### **Example:**

"A Desert Blooming." *Living Wild.* Writ. Marshall Reagan. Dir. Harry Gordon.

Prod. Peter Argentine. PBS. WTTW, Chicago. 29 April 2002.

## Online Video

"Segment Title." Director/Creator (if available). *Title of database or Website (italicized).*

Year of publication. Format. Date of access.

### **Example:**

"The Genius of Andrea Mantegna." Metropolitan Museum of Art. *YouTube.*

9 September 2009. Web. 31 January 2013.

### NOTE:

Line breaks should occur naturally.

Do not assume you have to break at the same place as the examples
